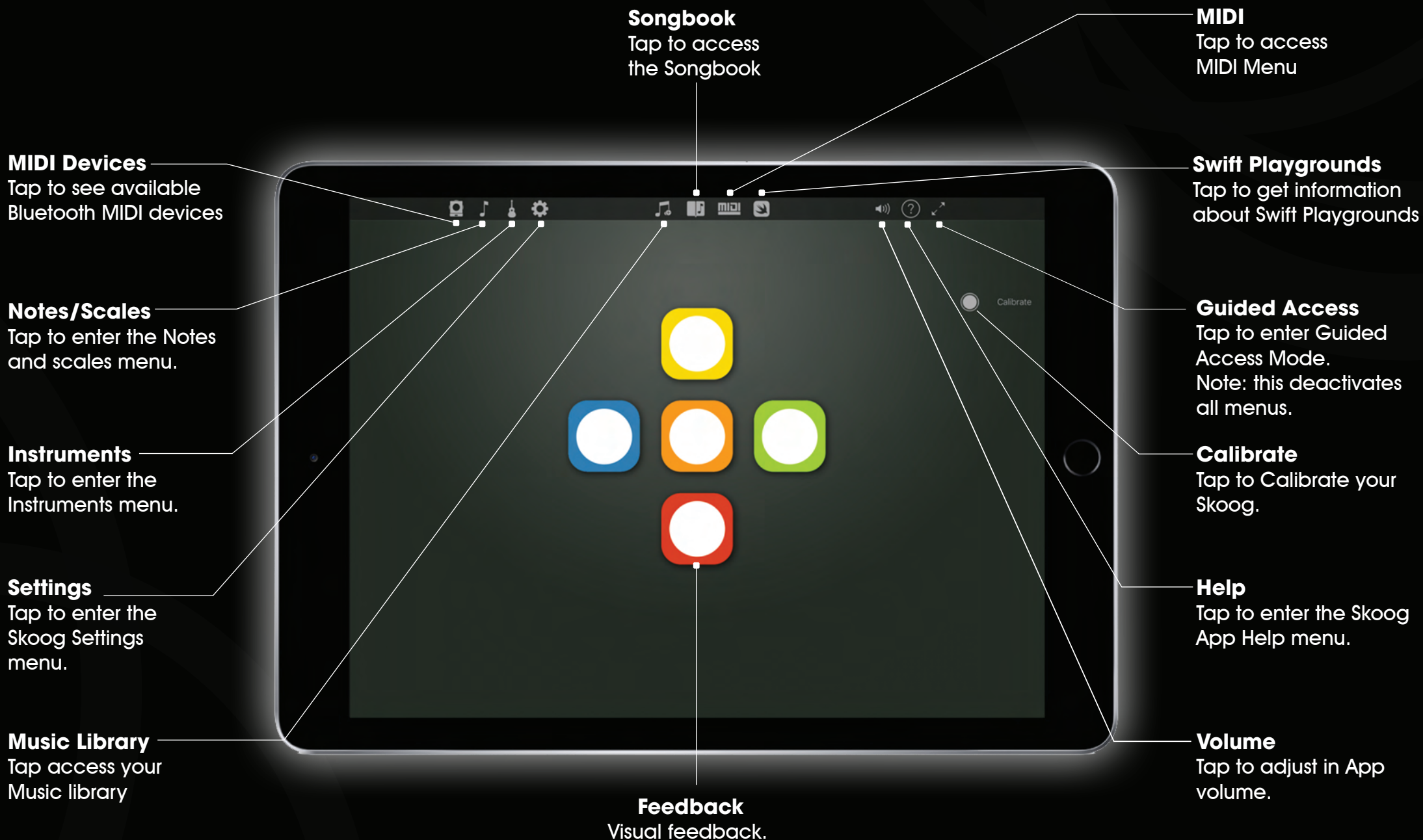
Download the Skoog App. Search your app store for **“Skoog”**

Instruments

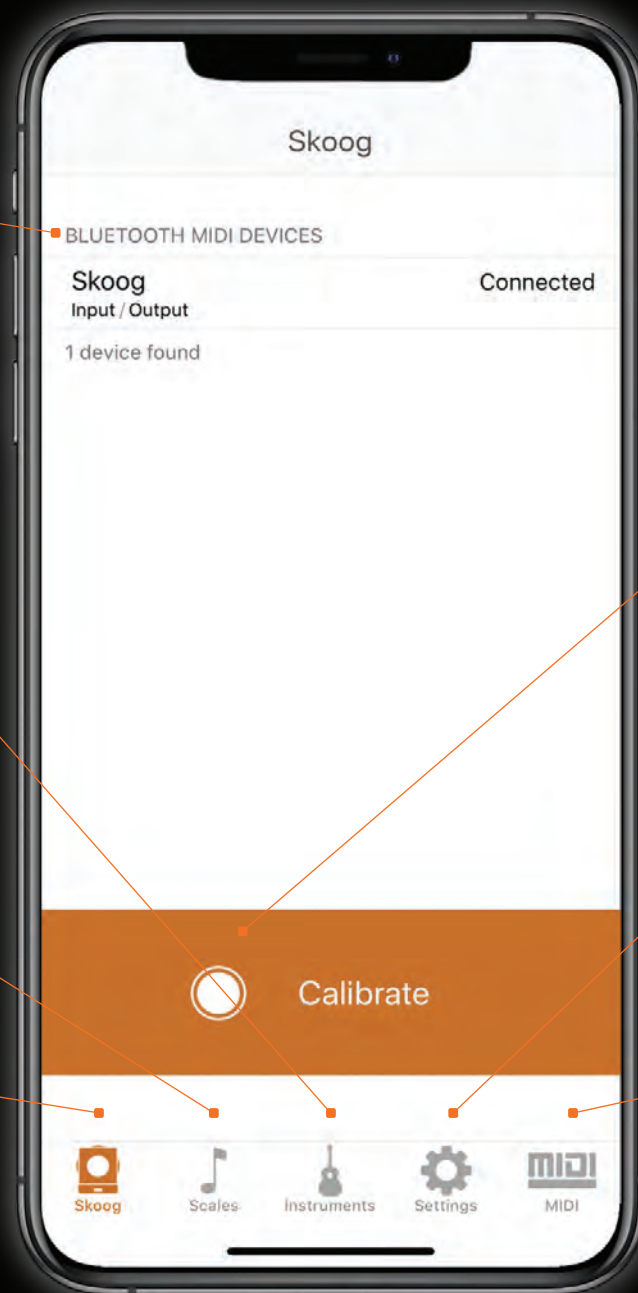
Tap to enter the Instruments menu.

Tap to access the MIDI menu.

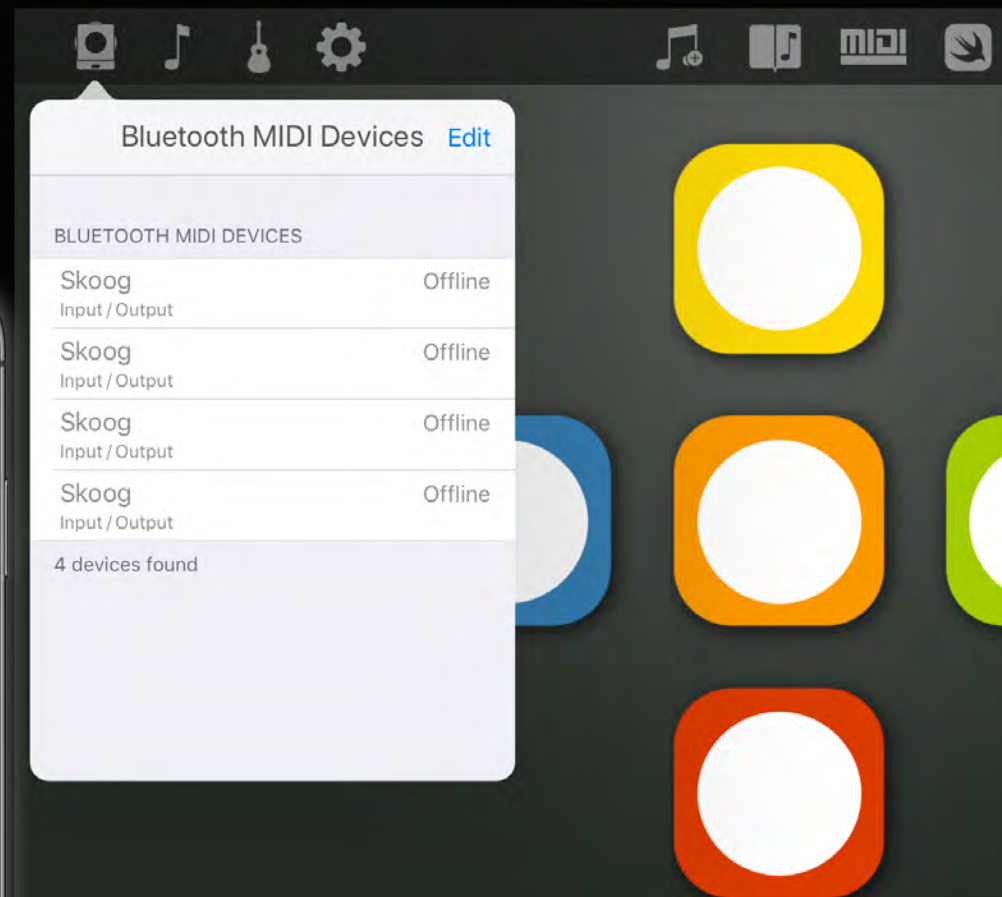
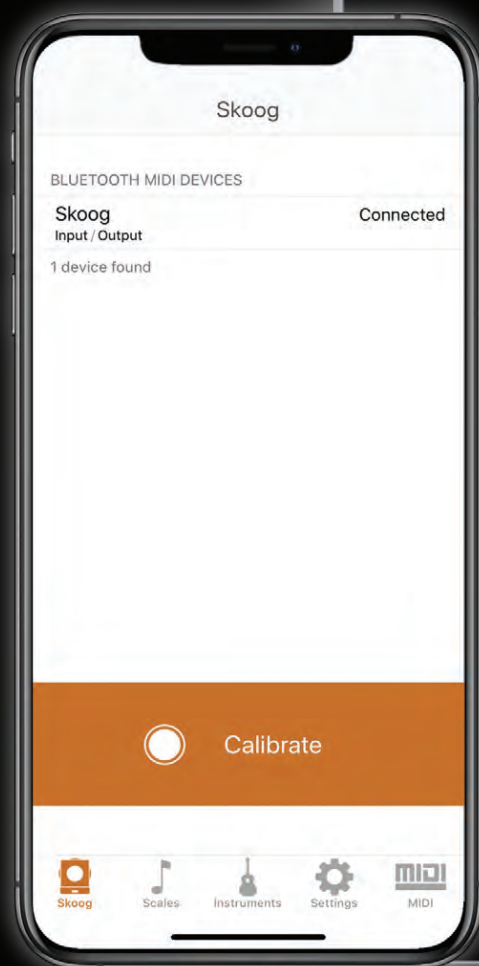


Bluetooth MIDI Device

The **Bluetooth MIDI Devices** menu allows you to connect your Skoog device to the Skoog App.

Make sure Bluetooth is switched on in your device settings.

Connect your Skoog by selecting it from the Bluetooth MIDI Device Menu.



Notes and Scales

The **Notes and scales menu** allows you adjust the notes and pitches assigned to the different sides of your Skoog.

You can select tuned scales (major or minor) change the Octave and manually select which note is assigned to each side/colour of your Skoog.

Change notes manually

Use the colour coded rollers to select a particular note. You can move the roller up or down to change the note. The Octave of each note is indicated by the number.

Key/tonic

Tap to select key.

Octave

Tap the + / - to increase or decrease the Octave from 0-6. A lower number means a lower pitch.

Scale

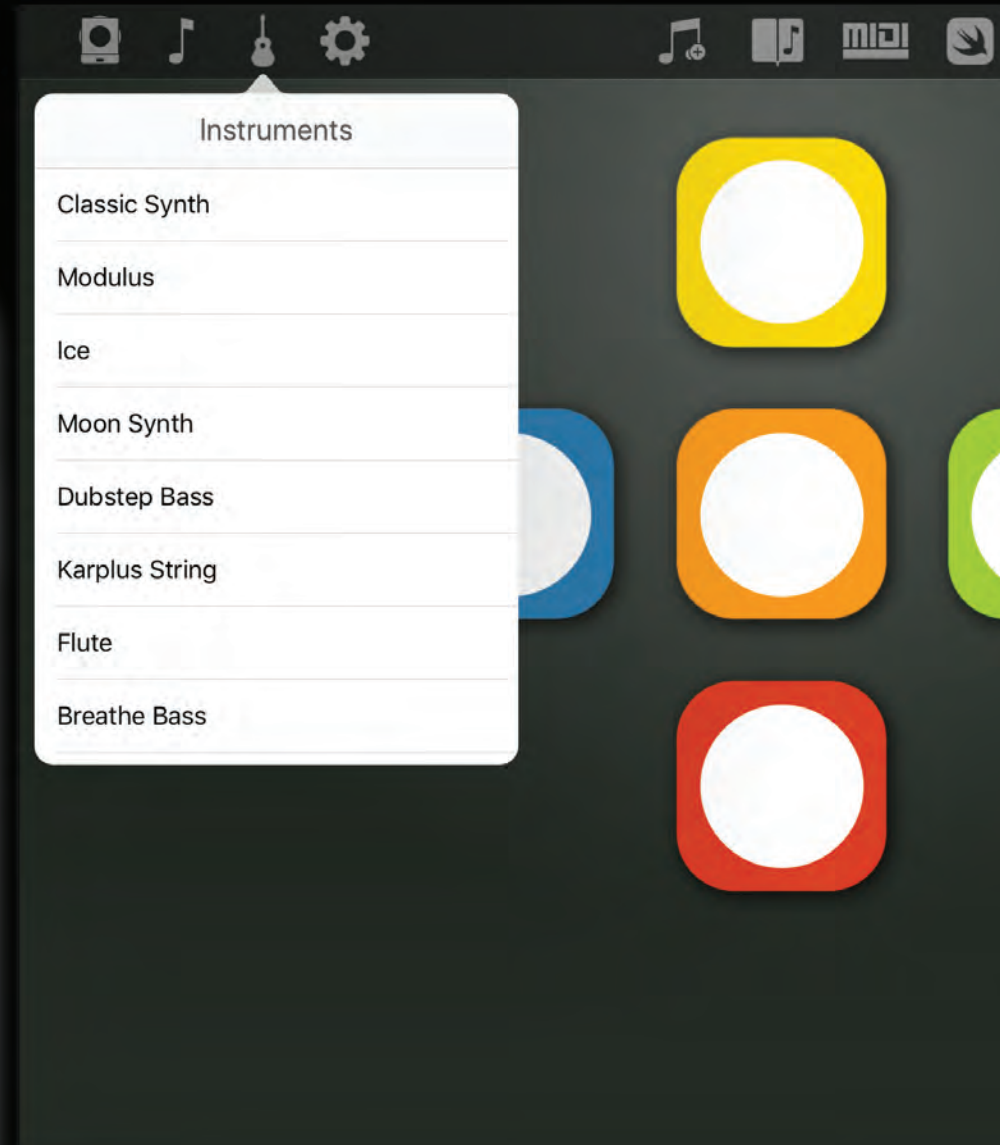
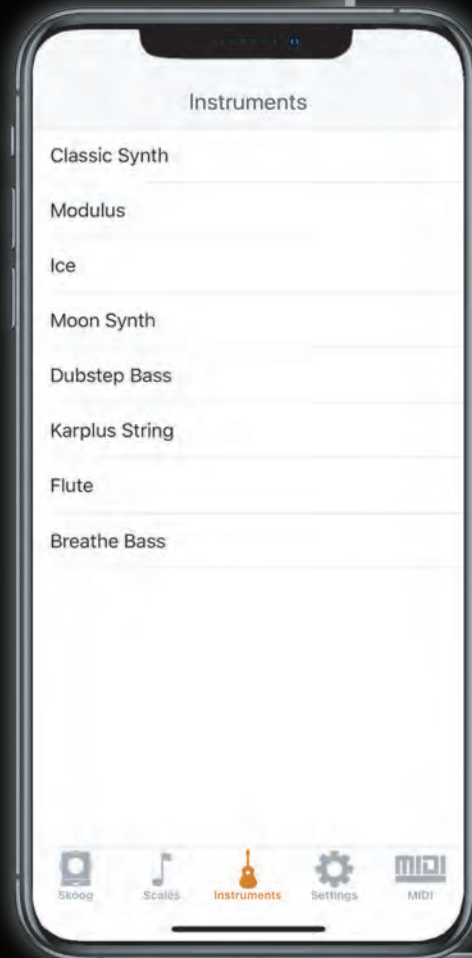
Select scale.



Instruments

The **Instruments** menu allows you to select a range of instruments.

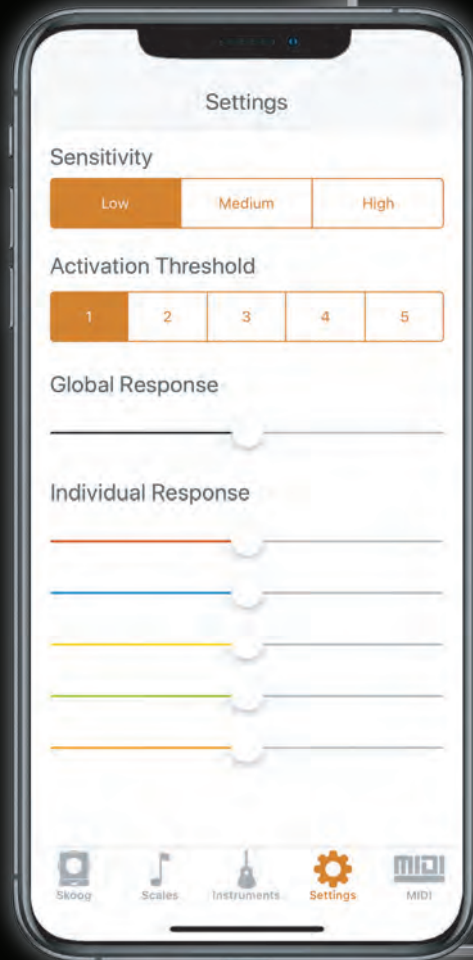
To choose an instrument, select the instrument sound from the list. Once you've selected an instrument. Press your Skoog to hear the sounds.



Settings

The **Settings** menu allows you to edit the settings of the Skoog to adjust the feedback and function.

Increase or decrease the sensitivity, adjust the pressure required to trigger your Skoog, turn off sides, adjust the activation threshold and more.

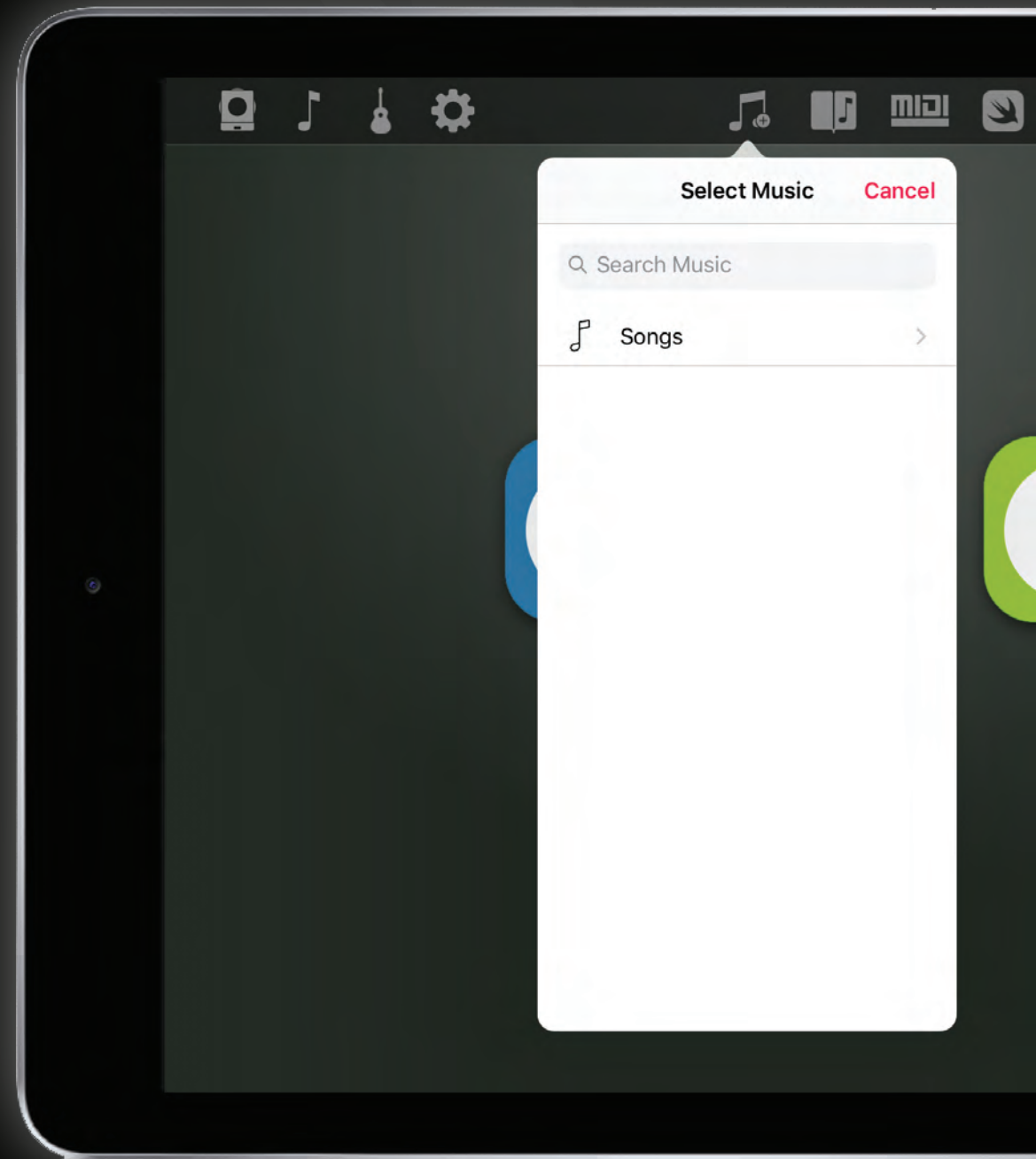




Music library

The **Music library** menu allows you to jam along with tunes from your media library - iTunes or Spotify.

To use iTunes or Spotify with your Skoog, open the Music library menu and select your chosen library.





In **Songbook** you can learn and play along with a selection of songs by following the colour sequences.

Using the Skoog's coloured buttons in combination with the right note settings you can use a colour sequence to learn and play along with your favourite songs.

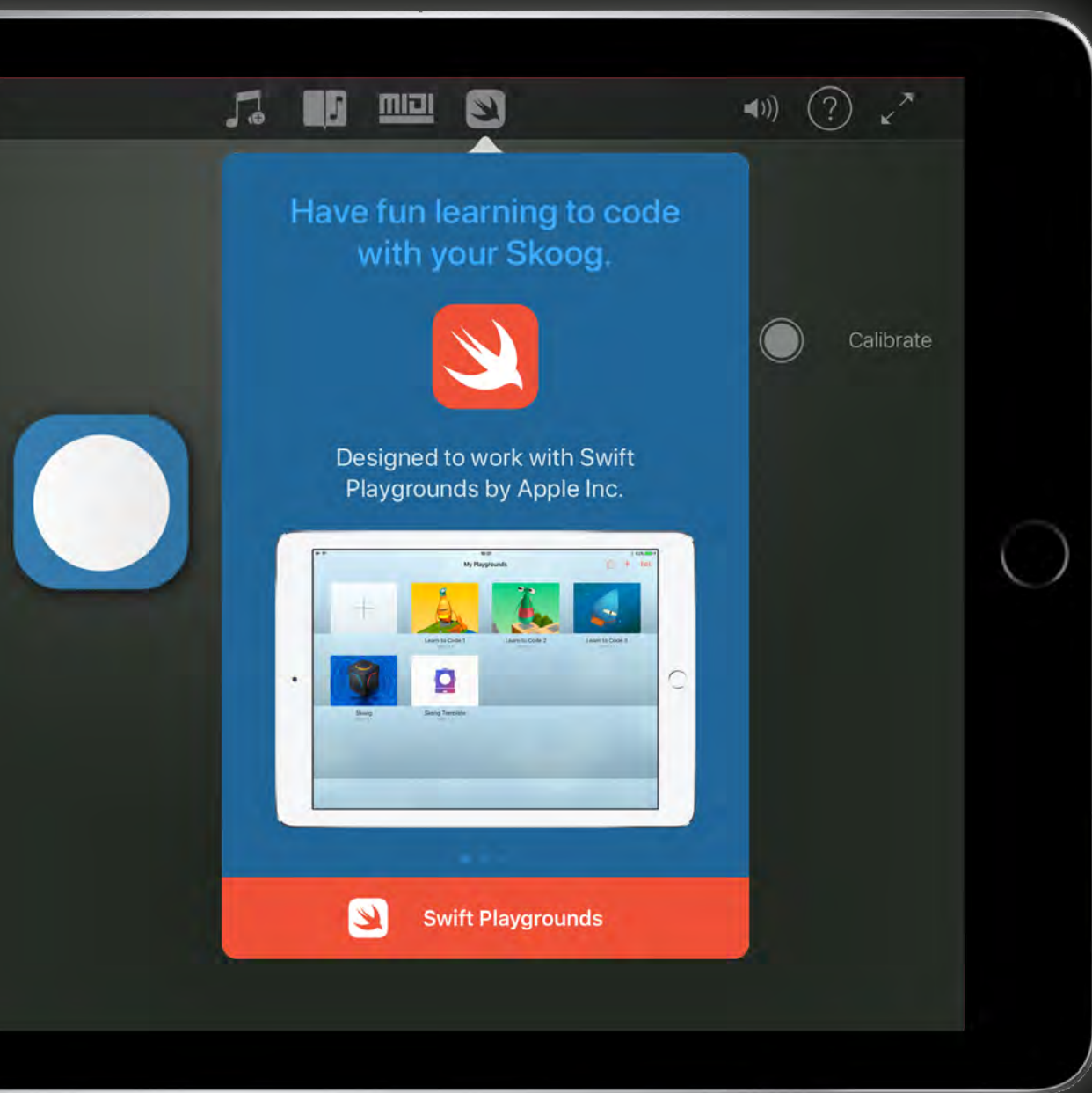
Bluetooth MIDI



The **Bluetooth MIDI menu** allows you to connect your Skoog to other MIDI compatible Apps.

Play new Instruments in GarageBand or turn your Skoog into a controller for other MIDI Apps - such as Noise (Rol).

Swift Playgrounds

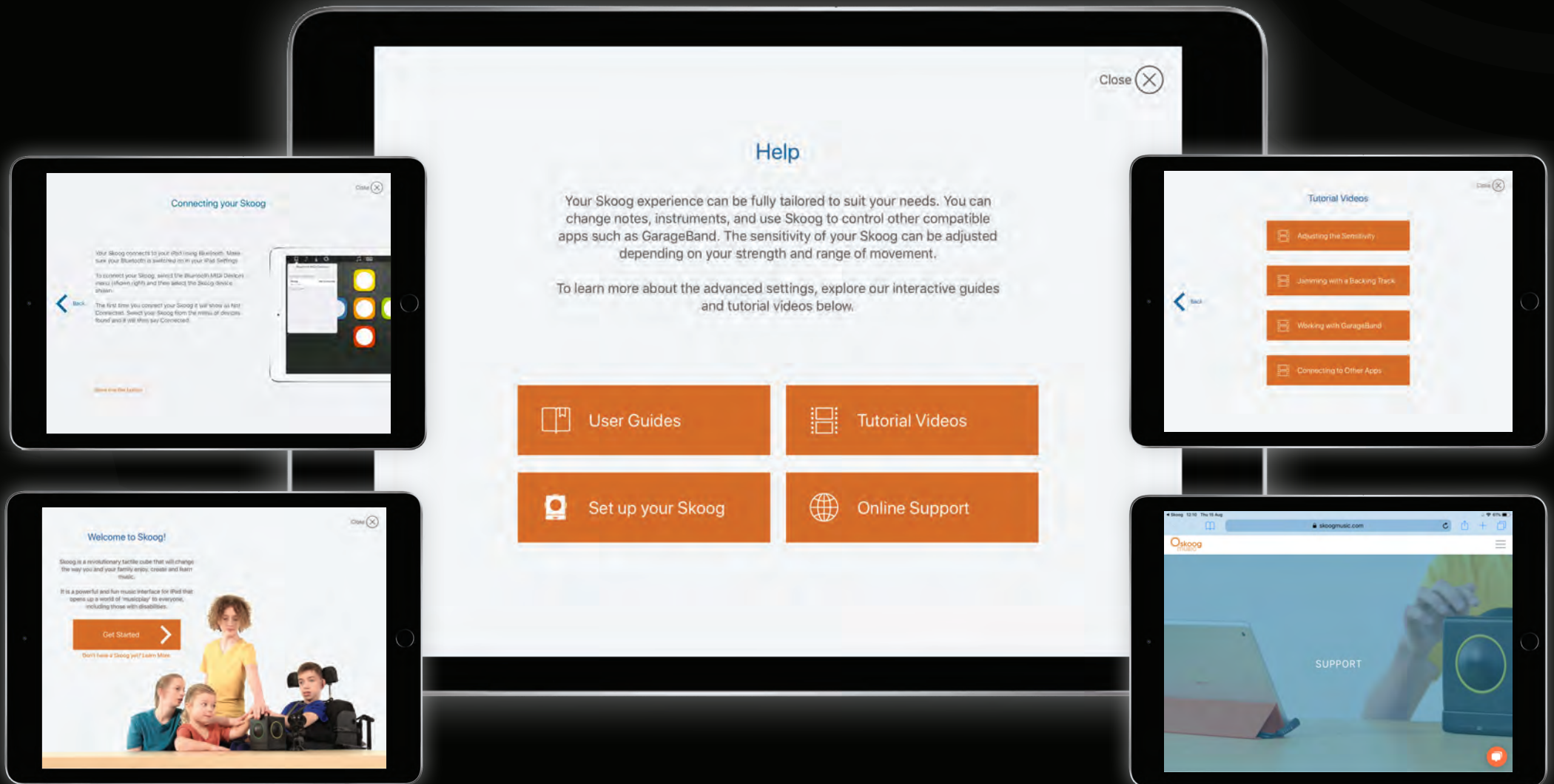


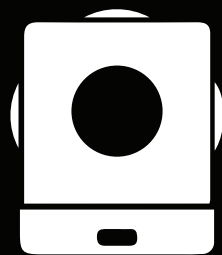
With **Swift Playgrounds** and your Skoog coding and music come to life. Build your own Instrument and play with data using your Skoogmusic device.
